AN ACT

Declaring Cheat river, in the county of Fayette, a public highway.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That from and after the passage of this act, Cheat river, from the mouth thereof, and up the said stream as far as the Virginia state line, be, and the same is hereby declared a public highway.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid*, That the Governor be, and he is hereby authorized and required to draw his warrant on the State Treasurer, in favour of Joseph Enix, Isaac Crow and James M'Cortney, of Fayette county, for five hundred dollars, who are hereby appointed commissioners to expend the same; who shall have power to cause to be removed all obstructions which impede or injure the navigation of said river Cheat, by removing rocks and other obstructions within the channel of said river, from the mouth of the aforesaid river up the same to the Virginia state line, and the said improvement to commence as early during the present year as convenient, and for that purpose to employ suitable persons to perform said work.

\$500 appropriated to be expended under direction of certain commissioners, in improvement of navigation.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid*, That the said commissioners shall each be entitled to receive one dollar and fifty cents per day, for every day neces-

sarily employed in performing the duties enjoined on them by this act, to be paid out of the treasury of Fayette county.

AN ACT

To authorize the Governor to incorporate the president, managers and company, of the Redbank and Clarion turnpike road company, in Armstrong county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Richard Reynolds, William Curl, George Means, Comm'rs appointed to open books, &c. John M. Rankin, James Waterson, Alexander M'Cain, Matthew Howsey, Charles Evans, John M'Gee, James Potter, Philip Clover, John C.
