

dams: *Provided nevertheless*, That every such dam be so constructed with a proper slope, erected in the most convenient and proper part thereof, so that crafts may not be obstructed in passing down the said stream, which slope shall be sufficiently wide to admit the crafts usually run upon said stream, to be one foot at least lower than the other parts of the dam, the surface of which slope shall be composed of wood or other suitable materials, well compacted together, and for every foot in height shall extend fifteen feet down stream.

AN ACT

Relating to the election of constables for the township of Mahoning, in Columbia county; and for the borough and township of Northampton, in Lehigh county.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That so much of the act entitled "An act to amend and consolidate with its supplements the act, entitled An act for the recovery of debts and demands, not exceeding one hundred dollars, before a justice of the peace, and for the election of constables, and for other purposes," passed the twentieth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and ten, which prohibits persons from serving as constables more than three years out of any six, be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as respects the township of Mahoning in the county of Columbia, and the borough and township of Northampton in the county of Lehigh.
