AN ACT

To incorporate sundry Fire Engine and Hose Companies.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same;* That all and every the persons who shall, at the time of passing this act, be members of the association called the Muncy Fire company, shall be and they are hereby created and declared to be one body politic and corporate, by the name, style and title, of "The Muncy Fire company," and by the same name shall have perpetual succession, and shall be able to sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, in all courts of record or elsewhere, and to purchase, receive, have, hold and enjoy, to them and their successors, lands, tenements, rents, annuities, franchises and hereditaments, goods and chattels, of what nature, kind or quality soever, real, personal or mixed, or choses in action, and the same from time to time to sell, grant, devise, alien or dispose of: *Provided,* That the clear yearly value or income of the real and personal estate of the said corporation, shall not exceed the sum of two thousand dollars, and also to make and have a common seal, and the same to break, alter and renew at pleasure, and also to ordain, establish and put in execution, such necessary and convenient for the government of the said corporation, not being contrary to this charter or the constitution and laws of the United States or of this Commonwealth, and generally to do all and singular the matters and things which to them shall lawfully appertain to do, for the well being of the said corporation, and the due management and ordering of the affairs thereof.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the following shall be the fundamental articles of said corporation.

Article I. The object of the company shall be the promotion of the public good by the extinguishment of fires.

Article II. The funds of the company shall be appropriated to no other objects than those for which the association was formed.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the persons who are or may hereafter be associated under the names, styles and titles, of the Columbia Fire Engine and Hose company of Germantown, the Perseverance Hose company of Philadelphia, the Columbia Hose

company of Philadelphia, the Weccacoe Fire company of Philadelphia, and the Northumberland Fire company, shall be and are hereby created into corporations and bodies politic, in law, under the names, styles and titles respectively, of The Columbia Fire Engine and Hose company of Germantown, The Perseverance Hose company of Philadelphia, The Columbia Hose company of Philadelphia, The Weccacoe Fire company of Philadelphia, and The Northumberland Fire company, with the powers, privileges and restrictions hereby conferred and imposed by the two foregoing sections of this act upon the Muncy Fire company.

AN ACT

To incorporate the society known by the name of the Norristown Baptist church, in the county of Montgomery.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the society known by the name of the Norristown Baptist church, in the county of Montgomery, is hereby erected into one body politic and corporate, in deed and in law, by the name, style, and title of the "Norristown Baptist church," and by the same name shall have perpetual succession, and be able to sue and be sued in all courts of law and elsewhere, and shall be able and capable in law and equity to take and hold lands and tenements, goods and chattels, of whatsoever kind, nature and quality, real, personal or mixed, which are now, or hereafter shall become the property of the said congregation, by gift, grant, bargain, sale, conveyance, assurance, will, devise, bequest, or otherwise, by any person or persons capable of making the same, and the same to grant, bargain, sell, mortgage or dispose of, and the yearly value or income of the real and personal estate
