AN ACT

For the relief of sundry soldiers and widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war.

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to William Wallace of Juniata county, William Butler of the city of Philadelphia, Frederick Nagle of Berks county, Abraham Fiscus of Armstrong county, Andrew Miller of York county, David Lamb of Centre county, and Jonathan Potts of Montgomery county, soldiers of the revolution, or to their respective orders, forty dollars to each immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each, during life, payable half yearly during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

\$40 grat. and ann. granted to W. Wallace, W. Butler, F. Nagle, A. Fiscus, A. Miller, D. Lamb and J. Potts.

SECT. 2. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Elizabeth Wallace of Allegheny county, and Margaretta Maudera of Berks county, the widows of soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to each of their orders, forty dollars immediately, and an annuity of forty dollars to each, during life, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

Same to Elizabeth Wallace and Margaretta Maudera.

SECT. 3. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the state Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to Robert Dunn of Franklin county, a gratuity of forty dollars in full for his revolutionary services.

\$40 grat to R. Dunn.

SECT. 4. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay to John Burkhart of Butler county, or order, forty dollars, as a gratuity for his captivity and sufferings in the Indian war.

Same to J. Burkhart.

SECT. 5. *And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay unto James Kerr and Michael Schmuck of York county, soldiers of the revolutionary war, or to their orders respectively, the sum of forty dollars immediately, and the sum of forty dollars annually during life, payable half yearly, to commence on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

SECT. 6. *And be it further enacted by the authority afore-
said, That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby author-
ized and required to pay to Catharine Shively of Montgom-
ery county, and Eve Gensler of York county, Mary M'Clcl-
land and Nancy Badger of Fayette county, widows of soldiers
of the revolutionary war, or to their orders respectively, the
sum of forty dollars immediately, and the sum of forty dol-
lars annually during life, payable half yearly, to commence
on the first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and
thirty-three.*

AN ACT

To authorize the construction of the abutments of the French creek
Feeder dam, at Bemus' mills, so that a bridge may be erected thereon.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the legislature that
a bridge is much wanted for the accommodation of the public
across French creek, at Bemus' mills in Crawford county,
and that much expense will be saved by constructing the
same on the abutments of the French creek Feeder dam lo-
cated at that place, Therefore

SECT. 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Repre-
sentatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General
Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the
same, That the canal commissioners of Pennsylvania, be
and they are hereby authorized and required so to construct
the abutments of the feeder dam at Bemus' mills, and the
dam itself, as that a bridge may be built thereon across the
said creek: Provided, That the assent of the owners of the
land on each side of French creek abutting on the said dam,
be obtained thereto.*
