Relative to calculating interest upon mortgages in the Land Office.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, That in calculating the amount due on mortgages to the Commonwealth, executed prior to the twenty-fifth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixteen, the Secretary of the Land Office shall make the same allowances and deductions, and make the calculation in the same way as if the mortgage had been executed subsequent to the said twenty-fifth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and sixteen.

RESOLUTION

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in General Assembly met, That the Auditor General be, and he is hereby authorized and required to collect from the estate of John De Pui, late clerk of the Senate, deceased, the balance due the Commonwealth from the estate of said deceased, as per report of the committee on accounts of the Senate made on the fifteenth day of February, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one, (per Senate Journal, page two hundred and sixty-eight of session one thousand eight hundred and thirty—thirty-one,) and the said Auditor General is hereby vested with full power and authority to bring suit in the name of the Commonwealth, against the legal representatives of said deceased, and to have and use all lawful ways and means for
