**An Act**

Extending the time limited in the will of William Work, deceased, for the sale of his real estate.

WHEREAS, by the last will and testament of William Work, late of the borough of West Chester, in the county of Chester, deceased, Harriet Work and Joseph Jones, his executors, were authorized and directed to sell all his real estate within one year after his decease: *And whereas*, it has been represented to the Legislature that the said executors were unable to effect a sale of a portion thereof, within the period named in the said will: Therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the said Harriet Work and Joseph Jones, or the survivor of them, be and they are hereby authorized to sell and dispose of the said real estate of said William Work, deceased, so remaining unsold, and to make good and effectual title to the purchaser, in as full and ample a manner as if the same had been sold, agreeably to the directions, and within the time prescribed in the will of the said deceased: *Provided*, the sale shall be effected within one year from the first of April next.

**A Supplement**

To an act entitled "An act for incorporating the Methodist Episcopal church, known by the name of Saint George's church, in the city of Philadelphia, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania," passed the eighth day of December, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine.

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of this Commonwealth, by an act passed the eighth day of December, one thousand seven hundred and eighty-nine, incorporated the congregation of the
