**A Supplement**

To an act entitled, "An act to incorporate the Chambersburg Insurance Company," passed the third day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the thirtieth section of the act entitled, An act to incorporate the Chambersburg Insurance company, &c., passed the third day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-three, as limits insurances against fire by the Chambersburg Insurance company to property in the county of Franklin, be and the same is hereby repealed; and that all policies to be made by said company, shall be valid and effectual, wherever the property insured be situated.

**An Act**

To confer on Mary Lavinia Leas the rights and benefits of a child born in lawful wedlock.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Mary Lavinia, the daughter of George W. Leas, late of Adams county, and Margaret Leas, (late Margaret Grove, of Franklin county,) born some time before the marriage of the said George W. and Margaret Leas, shall have and enjoy all the rights, benefits and advantages of a child born in lawful wedlock, and shall be able and capable in law to inherit and transmit any estate whatsoever, as fully and com-

pletely, to all intents and purposes, as if she had been born subsequently to the marriage of her aforesaid parents.

### An Act

To alter the time of holding the Courts in Susquehanna county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act of the fourteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, as requires the courts in Susquehanna county to commence on the first Monday of December in each year, and continue one week, be and the same is hereby repealed, and, in lieu thereof, the said courts shall hereafter commence on the third Monday in November of each year, and continue two weeks: *Provided,* That the judges may at the preceding September term make and order that such November term shall continue one week only.
