An Act

To authorize the commissioners of Tioga county to borrow money for the use of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of the county of Tioga, or a majority of them, be authorized to borrow, on such terms as they may deem most advantageous to the interest of said county, any sum or sums of money, not exceeding eight thousand dollars, for the purpose of erecting the public buildings of said county; and for the repayment of which they are hereby authorized to enter into such contract or contracts as shall pledge the credit of said county for the same, and hold their successors in office for the payment of the same, as shall be stipulated by said commissioners.

An Act

To alter the time of holding township elections in Buckingham township, Wayne county, and for the election of a constable in the borough of Brookville, in Jefferson county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act the electors of the township of Buckingham, in the county of Wayne, shall hold their election for township officers on the third February annually, and that the meeting of the township auditors shall be on the Monday following the said third February. Elections of Buckingham township, Wayne co. for officers, held on 3d Friday of February annually."

Part of act of 1834 repealed SECTION 2. So much of the act of fifteenth April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, as relates to the time of holding elections in said township and the meeting of township auditors, is hereby repealed.

Election of constable in Brookville, Jefferson co. SECTION 3. The qualified electors of the borough of Brookville, in the county of Jefferson, shall annually hereafter, on the third Friday of March, at the usual place of holding their borough elections, elect two reputable citizens of said borough, and return the names of the persons so elected to the next Court of Quarter Sessions of said county, one of whom shall be appointed constable of said borough, in the same manner, with the like power and authority, and subject to the same regulations and penalties as are provided and contained in the laws now existing or that may hereafter exist, concerning township constables within this Commonwealth; which said elections shall be held and conducted by the same persons, and in the same manner, as the elections for borough officers in said borough are held and conducted.

An Act

To increase the compensation of the judge of the District Court of the city and county of Lancaster.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the first day of May next, the judge of the District Court of the city and county of Lancaster, shall receive a yearly compensation of four hundred dollars, in addition to the salary now payable to him by law.
