An Act

To annul the marriage contract of Charles Crillon Barton and Anna his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into by and between Charles Crillon Barton and Anna his wife, late Anna Hollingshead, both of the city of Philadelphia, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from the said contract, and from all duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully and effectually and absolutely as if they never had been joined in marriage.
