

to purchase and hold in the counties of Centre and Lycoming not exceeding six thousand acres of land, including that which they have already purchased; and also to purchase and hold not exceeding three acres in any other parts of the State where they may deem it useful, either for landings, places of deposite, or other purposes, connected with the prosecution of their business: *Provided*, That the said six thousand acres shall not consist of more than six distinct and separate bodies of land.

## A Supplement

To an act entitled An act authorizing the Governor to incorporate the Lackawana and Susquehanna rail-road company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That the time for carrying into effect the objects of the charter of the Lackawana and Susquehanna rail-road company shall be extended for ten years after the eleventh day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, and that the annual and special elections shall be held at Carbondale until otherwise directed by the by-laws; also, that so much of any law as is altered or supplied be and the same is hereby repealed.
