AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of John Zuercher, and Magdalena Zuercher, his wife.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same:* That the marriage contract entered into by and between John Zuercher, and Magdalena Zuercher, his wife, ^{Divorce of} be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the ^{John Zuercher.} parties released and discharged from the said contract, and from all the legal duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage.
