AN ACT

To extend the time for completing "the Norristown and Valley rail road,"
and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Norristown and Valley rail road company, be and they are hereby allowed until the fifteenth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, for the completion of the said road: *Provided,* ^{Road to be completed in 1845} That the said company, or their assignees, shall within six months from the passage of this act, give a bond with security, to be approved of by the court of common pleas of Chester county, conditioned for compliance with the provisions of the twelfth and thirteenth sections of the act, entitled "an act to authorize the Governor to incorporate the Norristown and Valley rail road company, and for other purposes," passed April the fifteenth, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-five, and to pay and satisfy the owners through whose land the said road passes, and to pay for materials already used, and that proceedings may be had under the said act for damage done, and for materials as fully as if the said road was completed; and in case of non-compliance with this proviso, this act shall at the expiration of said six months expire.
