AN ACT

For the relief of the Reading Artillerists, of Berks county, and certain other Volunteer companies, of Lebanon county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Reading Artillerists, of Berks county, the Jonestown Guards, and the Washington Rifle Company, of the borough of Lebanon, in Lebanon county, shall, after the passage of this act, be exempt from training with any regiment or battalion of Militia, except at their discretion: *Provided,* That the above named companies shall meet the proper number of days annually required by law in their company capacity.
