RESOLUTION

Directing a *Nolle Prosequi* to be entered in certain criminal prosecutions against George Handy.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, That the attorney general of this commonwealth be and is hereby authorized and directed to enter a *nolle prosequi* in Attorney Gen any criminal proceedings had or to be had in any court of this *nolle prosequi* commonwealth against George Handy for or on account of any act or participation by him in obtaining, receiving or disbursing any money from the United States Bank, of Pennsylvania, or conspiring with any other person or persons to influence the action of the Legislature or Executive, in the year eighteen hundred and forty, in regard to the banks of this commonwealth: *Provided*, That before the attorney general *Proviso* shall enter a *nolle prosequi* the said George Handy shall appear before either branch of the legislature or a joint committee by them properly constituted, and then and there testify all his knowledge in relation to said transaction.
