## RESOLUTION

Changing the time of electing State Treasurer.

Election 3d  
Monday in  
January

**SECTION 1.** *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,* That the Senate and House of Representatives shall, at twelve o'clock meridian, on the third Monday of January, in the present and each succeeding year, proceed to elect a State Treasurer, in the manner provided by the act, entitled "An act relating to elections of this Commonwealth," passed the second day of July, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, for which purpose each branch of the legislature shall, on the same day, or on Saturday immediately preceding, appoint a teller to act at said election, and that so much of any law as is hereby altered or supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.
