RESOLUTION

Relative to the Records of the Susquehanna Company, and for other purposes.

Recorder of
Luzerne co

Proviso

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, That the recorder of the county of Luzerne is hereby authorized to take and receive the records of the Susquehanna company from the land office, and keep the same in the recorder's office in the borough of Wilkesbarre, for the inspection of all persons on the payment of the necessary fees in such cases allowed by law: *Provided*, That the recorder shall not permit the same to be taken from his office, unless on the requisition of the Governor or the secretary of the land office, either of whom may direct the said records to be returned at any time to the land office of this commonwealth.

Boro of York
town plot

RESOLVED, That the copy of the original town plot of the borough of York, in the county of York, now in the office of the surveyor general of this commonwealth, and copies thereof duly certified by the surveyor general or secretary of the land office, shall be evidence, in the trial of any cause, to show the location and boundary of lots in said borough, as well as the location of the streets, lanes and alleys, and the width of the same.

RESOLVED, That the powers and privileges granted to the Pennsylvania company for insurances on lives and granting annuities, by the act entitled "An act to incorporate the Pennsylvania Company for insurances on lives, granting annuities, and for other purposes," passed the tenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and twelve, and the several supplements thereto, be and the same are hereby extended to the Equitable Insurance, Life Insurance, Annuity and Trust Company.
