RESOLUTION

Relative to the ordinary expenses of Government.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met,* That the State Treasurer be and he is hereby authorized, Ordinary ex-
to pay out of any moneys in the treasury, the sum of two penses \$200,-
hundred thousand dollars, for the ordinary expenses of go-000
vernment, viz : pensions, judiciary, military expenses, officers
of the government, common schools, clerk hire and miscella-
neous, penitentiaries, contingent expenses, colleges, academies
and female seminaries, and that the State Treasurer be autho-
rized to pay out for repairs on finished lines the sum of one Repairs
hundred thousand dollars from tolls and revenues, arising from \$100,000
the internal improvements.
