RESOLUTION

Relative to the payment of interest to Domestic Creditors.

Creditors Au- **RESOLVED,** *By the Senate and House of Representatives*
ditor Gen *of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assem-*
bly met, That such of the creditors of the commonwealth, as
Interest do not choose to receive certificates of stock, shall be entitled
 to a credit for the amount of their claim on the books of the
 Auditor General, and shall receive interest at six per cent, on
 balances due for work done prior to the fourth of May, one
 thousand eight hundred and forty-one; interest shall be allowed
 from that date, and on balances due for work done since the
 fourth of May, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, in-
 terest to be allowed from the passage of this act, the interest
 to be paid semi-annually to the respective holders out of any
 money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
