RESOLUTION

Relative to the Courts of Common Pleas of Berks county, and for other purposes.

Be it resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same, That the sixteenth section of the act entitled "An act to change the venue in a certain action now pending in the court of common pleas, of Clarion county, and for other purposes," passed the seventeenth day of March, eighteen hundred and forty-two, which changes the time of holding the court of common pleas in Berks county, be repealed from and after the first day of October next, and the same is hereby repealed.

Part of former law repealed

RESOLVED, That all the right of the Commonwealth, in and to the real estate of which David Hamilton alias David Crouch, deceased, died seized or possessed, and which said estate has escheated to the Commonwealth be and hereby is vested in the administrator of the estate of said decedent, in trust for the following purposes, viz: said administrator shall have full power and authority, and is required to sell at public vendue or outcry on or before the first Monday of November, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, all the real estate of said decedent situate in Nottingham township, Washington county, adjoining lands of John Hamilton and Andrew Baitty, heirs of Samuel Munn, James McMurry, John

Munn and Leverton Thomas, and containing eighty-six acres and ninety-six perches, four weeks notice of the time and place of such sale to be given in one or more newspapers printed in the said county of Washington, and the said administrator shall, out of the proceeds of the sale of said estate, first pay all legal demands against said decedent at the time of his death, and the balance of said proceeds deducting therefrom, reasonable expenses, shall as soon as they come into the hands of the administrator, be paid over to Rachel Hamilton, the mother of said decedent: *Provided*, The said administrator shall, before selling said real estate hereby vested in trust for the purposes aforesaid, give bond in the name of the Commonwealth, in such sum and with such security as the court of common pleas, of said Washington county may approve, and conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of the trust under this law: *Provided moreover*, That the said real estate shall not be sold before the first Monday of November, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, unless with the consent and approbation of the said Rachel Hamilton first had and obtained: *And Provided further*, That the sale thereof, shall be confirmed by the said court before a deed is made to the purchaser: *And Provided also*, That all the expenses which have been incurred on the proceedings vesting this property in the Commonwealth, shall be paid out of the proceeds of the sale of said estate.
