RESOLUTION

Relative to the payment of Militia expenses.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, That the state treasurer be and he is hereby required to pay, out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the secretary of the commonwealth, the necessary expenses incurred in printing the militia commissions for the officers elected in June last, and to be elected in August next; also the postage upon the returns of election of militia officers, and such other necessary expenses incurred in issuing said commissions as are unavoidable: *Pro-Provided*, That the secretary of the commonwealth, shall keep a separate and correct account of said expenses, and the same shall be settled and allowed by the auditor general and state treasurer in the usual manner.
