RESOLUTION

To authorize the State Treasurer to pay the amounts due the Pennsylvania Institution, for the Instruction of the Blind, and the Pennsylvania Institution for the Deaf and Dumb.

Preamble

WHEREAS, a large part of the loan authorized by the "Act to provide revenue to meet the demands on the treasury, and for other purposes," passed the fourth of May, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, was not subscribed for in consequence whereof the appropriations made in the said act to the asylums of the blind, and the deaf and dumb, have not been paid:

And whereas, the legislature deem it incumbent to provide for the payment of the expense incurred by those benevolent institutions, for the instruction of the indigent pupils of the Commonwealth; therefore,

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, 'That the State Treasurer, be and he is hereby authorized and required to pay, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the treasurer of "The Pennsylvania Institution, for the Instruction of the Blind," and to the treasurer of "The Pennsylvania Institution, for the Deaf and Dumb," the amount due to each institution respectively, for the instruction and support of the indigent pupils of the Commonwealth, for the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, in conformity with the provisions of the existing laws.
