AN ACT

Supplementary to "An Act relating to counties and townships, and county and township officers."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the eighty-first section of the act of assembly of the fifteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-four, entitled "An Act relating to counties and townships, and county and township officers," as requires the election of three supervisors, be and the same is hereby repealed so far as relates to the township of Canaan, in the county of Wayne; and the electors of said township shall annually hereafter, at the time of holding their township elections, elect two persons as supervisors of highways, and two persons as overseers of the poor of said township, who shall serve for one year, and until their successors are duly elected and qualified; and the said supervisors shall be subject to all the duties and responsibilities of supervisors of highways, and the said overseers of the poor shall be subject to all the duties and responsibilities of overseers of the poor, provided for by the act to which this is a supplement.

AN ACT

To authorize the Washington insurance company of Philadelphia, to wind up and close the affairs of said company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That as soon as four-fifths of the number of persons holding stock, either in their own right or in a representative capacity, in the Washington insurance company of Philadelphia, and holding together more than four-fifths of the whole number of shares of the capital stock, shall give
