A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to authorize the commissioners of the incorporated districts of the county of Philadelphia, to construct works for supplying said districts with water, from the Schuylkill river."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same.* That the judges of the court of quarter sessions, of the county of Philadelphia, shall, on the first Saturday in March of the present year, cause a jury to be drawn from the December list of road jurors, to assess the damages on Thompson street, from the Ridge road, to the Columbia and Philadelphia railroad, as laid down on the plan of Penn township, in the county of Philadelphia; and it shall be the duty of said jury, within two weeks after their appointment, to meet and view said street and assess the damages, and make their report of the same to the water commissioners of Spring Garden and the Northern Liberties, which report shall be final, and the amount of said damages shall be forthwith paid by the said water commissioners.

SECTION 2. That the water commissioners of Spring Garden and the Northern Liberties, be and they are hereby authorized to lay pipes of conduit along the Ridge road, from Thompson street, to the northern line of Spring Garden: *Provided*, That the said water commissioners shall not take up any more of the said road than is absolutely necessary for the purpose aforesaid: *And provided further*, That all injury or damage done to the said road, shall immediately thereafter be repaired by the said water commissioners.
