AN ACT

Authorizing the State Treasurer to refund to the Rev. Dr. Joseph McElroy, certain moneys erroneously paid by him into the State Treasury.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and required to refund to the Rev. Dr. Joseph McElroy, the sum of sixty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents, the said amount having been erroneously paid into the state treasury as the collateral inheritance tax on the estate of Mrs. Sarah McElroy, late of the city of New York, deceased.

AN ACT

Supplementary to the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Mutual fire insurance company of Sinking Springs, Berks county," approved the twelfth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three.
