A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of Shirleysburg, in the county of Huntingdon, into a borough, and for other purposes," passed the third day of April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-seven.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the boundary of the borough of Shirleysburg, shall be extended on the lands of Thomas A. Smelker, beginning on a line of East street, by lot of Britton E. Collins, and extending eastwardly; thence southwardly; thence westwardly, until it shall meet the line of Main street or Great road; thence to line of said borough, along said line to place of beginning, including ten acres of land, as near square as the courses and distances will allow; which land and survey shall embrace the buildings and improvements of said Smelker. Boundary extended.

SECTION 2. That all the property, real and personal aforesaid, together with all the inhabitants within the same, shall be subject to all regulations, privileges and expenses, in like manner that other citizens of the borough are subject to, by authority of the corporate powers vested in the burgess and town council of the said borough, for all borough purposes.

SECTION 3. That the entire tract of land belonging to the said Thomas A. Smelker, adjoining the borough of Shirleysburg, shall be included in the school district, of which the borough of Shirleysburg is declared independent; and shall be taxed, together with other borough property included in the district, for school purposes, as equal in assessed value as may be ascertained by the assessors, valuing all other property in said borough.
