AN ACT

Authorizing the governor to appoint a sealer of weights and measures, in and for the county of Wayne.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall be the duty of the governor of this commonwealth, to appoint a sealer of weights and measures, in and for the county of Wayne, to hold his office for three years.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of said sealer of weights and measures, to take charge of the standard of measure of length, of capacity, and of weight, furnished to said county, agreeable to act of assembly, and shall by them regulate and adjust all the weights and measures of said county, on application to him for that purpose; which shall be stamped with a suitable seal, and his name, or the initials thereof; and for which service he shall be entitled to receive the same fees as are provided to be paid to the sealer of weights and measures in the city and county of Philadelphia, for similar services.
