For the benefit of Bridget Trucks.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and required to pay to Bridget Trucks, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, for timber furnished by George Trucks, deceased, husband of the said Bridget, for the use of the commonwealth, on the Western division of the Pennsylvania canal: *Provided,* That this act shall be deemed and taken to be a full satisfaction of all claims and demands whatsoever, due by the commonwealth, to the estate of the said George Trucks, deceased, on any account whatever.

A N A C T

To authorize the incorporation of a company to erect a bridge over the Kiskiminetas river, at or near Warren, Armstrong county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That John Reed, William Wilson and William Chambers of Westmoreland county, Sherman Bills, Hugh Bigham and James Guthrie of Armstrong county, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to perform the duties hereinafter mentioned—that is to say: They or a majority of them shall, on or before the first Monday of August next, provide one or more books for the entering of subscriptions, and shall write therein as follows: “We, whose names are hereunto subscribed, do promise to pay to the Form of subscription. president, managers and company, for erecting a bridge over the Kiskiminetas river at or near the town of Warren, in Armstrong county, the sum of twenty dollars for every share of stock, in the said company, set
