AN ACT

Authorizing the committee of Jacob K. Landis to purchase real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That John Miller and Henry Bear, committee of Jacob K. Landis, late of Manheim township, Lancaster county, are hereby authorized to purchase for the use of the said Jacob K. Landis, a house and lot in East Hempfield township, in said county, at a price not exceeding eight hundred and fifty dollars, and hold the same in trust for the use of the said Jacob K. Landis and his heirs: *Provided*, That the said committee shall not give any judgment, mortgage or other securities to the vendors of said house and lot, that will be a lien or incumbrance upon any other real estate of the said Jacob K. Landis; and they or their successors to hold the same in trust for the use of the said Jacob K. Landis, and his heirs, in the same manner as the real estate now belonging to the said Jacob K. Landis is held.
