AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of Ezekiel Daniels, and Candace, his wife:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the marriage contract entered into by Ezekiel Daniels, and Candace, his wife, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from the said contract, as fully and effectually and absolutely, as if they never had been joined in marriage.*

AN ACT

To authorize the adjutant general to furnish the Goshenhoppen Dragoons with arms.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the adjutant general of this commonwealth be and he is hereby authorized and required to issue, upon the requisition of the proper brigade inspector, out of any arms remaining in any of the state arsenals, the usual number of holsters and pistols, sabres and belts, for the use of the*
