AN ACT

Relating to taxes on real estate in the county of Allegheny.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the provisions of the act, entitled “An Act relating to taxes on certain real estate in the city and county of Philadelphia,” passed the third day of February, one thousand eight hundred and twenty-four, except the eighth section, be, and the same are hereby extended to the county of Allegheny; and all and singular the provisions of said act, shall be deemed and taken to apply to taxes, rates and levies, imposed or assessed for either state, county, or corporation purposes, by authority of any law of this commonwealth, or by authority of the county of Allegheny, or of any city or other corporation in said county, upon real estate situated in the said corporations or county, except water rents, which shall not be considered as coming within the provisions of this act.

AN ACT

To authorize Jonathan Newmyer and Benjamin Shallenborger, executors of the last will and testament of John Pippit, deceased, late of Bullsken township, Fayette county, to sell real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Jonathan Newmyer and Benjamin Shallenborger, executors of the last will and testament of John Pippit, deceased, late of Fayette county, be, and they are hereby authorized to sell at public or private sale, upon such terms as they may deem expedient, all the real estate in the county of Fayette, of which said testator was seized at the time of his death;
