A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled “An Act to authorize the governor to incorporate the president, managers, and company of the Armstrong and Clearfield turnpike road company,” approved the seventeenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-one.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time for the completion of the Armstrong and Clearfield turnpike Completion ex-road, be and the same is hereby extended for the term of ten years, tended. from and after the passage of this act.*
