A SUPPLEMENT

To the act to incorporate the Mutual beneficial insurance association of Bucks county, against losses by fire, and for other purposes, passed the twenty-fourth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act the said association shall have full power and authority to effect insurances on all property designated by Insurances. the act to which this is a supplement, without regard to its location, any thing in the said act to the contrary notwithstanding.

AN ACT

To incorporate the Methodist Episcopal congregation at Willardsburg, in the county of Tioga.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Methodist Episcopal congregation, in the village of Willardsburg, Incorporated. in the county of Tioga, and state of Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby enacted into a body politic and corporate, in deed and in law, by the name, style and title of the "Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Name. church in the village of Willardsburg," and by the same name shall have perpetual succession; and the present trustees who have been ap- Trustees. pointed agreeably to the discipline of the church, or their successors in office, shall be able to sue and be sued, to plead and be impleaded in all Powers, &c. courts of law and equity, and shall be able and capable in law and equity to take and to hold to them and their successors, for the use of the said church, lands, tenements, goods and chattels, which now is, or shall hereafter become the property of the said church, and the same to grant,

bargain and sell, or otherwise dispose of for the use of the said church :
Provido. *Provided*, That the yearly value or income of said estate shall not at any one time exceed the sum of two thousand dollars.

AN ACT

For the relief of R. C. Newport.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the canal commissioners be and they are hereby authorized to settle the claim of R. C. Newport, for rebuilding or repairing one of the state bridges over the canal, in the borough of Sharpsburg, county of Allegheny, and allow him the amount actually expended in the repairing or rebuilding said bridge, not exceeding the sum of fifty dollars, and draw their warrant for the amount, upon the state treasurer, who is authorized to pay the same out of the repair fund.*
