Authorizing the auditor general to settle the claim of the Columbia Bank and Bridge company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the auditor general is hereby authorized and required to examine into and adjust the accounts of the Columbia Bank and Bridge company, and if it shall appear that they have at any time overpaid any sum or sums for tax or dividends of said bank and bridge company, the amount so overpaid shall be entered as a credit to their account, on the books of the auditor general.
