AN ACT

To authorize the town council of the borough of Williamsport, in the county of Lycoming, to appoint overseers of the poor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the town council of the borough of Williamsport, in the county of Lycoming, shall annually appoint two suitable persons overseers of the poor of the said borough, who shall perform all the duties imposed by law on overseers of the poor, and be subject to the same responsibilities by virtue of their office: they shall render their account to the town council once in every year for settlement, or oftener, if required, and shall moreover be subject to such rules and regulations as the said town council may from time to time ordain, not inconsistent with the laws of this commonwealth.
