A N A C T

Relative to the Mount Carbon railroad company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That it shall not be lawful for the Mount Carbon railroad company to charge, before the completion of their road, a higher rate of toll on any commodities transported over the same, than they are authorized to charge under their charter, on the completion of said road; and the violation of the provisions of this act, shall be deemed a forfeiture of all and singular the rights and privileges conferred upon said company by their act of incorporation.*
