A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An Act authorizing the governor to incorporate the North Branch canal company," passed the twenty-second day of July, one thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the time within which the said company are required to commence the Commencement work on said canal, shall be extended two years from the first day of and completion May next; and the time within which they shall complete the same, is hereby extended six years from the said first day of May next, extended.

AN ACT

To confer on certain persons therein named, the rights and benefits of children born in lawful wedlock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That John Brubecker, son of Susanna Henly, of the township of West Co- John Brubecker. calico, in the county of Lancaster, and commonwealth of Pennsylvania, shall have and enjoy all the rights, benefits and advantages of a child born in lawful wedlock; and shall be able and capable in law to inherit and transmit any estate whatsoever, as fully and completely, to all intents and purposes, as if he had been born in lawful wedlock.

SECTION 2. That Jacob W. Barnes, of the county of Bucks, shall Jacob W. Barnes. have and enjoy all the rights and advantages of a child born in lawful wedlock; and shall be able and capable in law to inherit and transmit any estate whatsoever, as fully and completely, to all intents and purposes, as if he had been born in lawful wedlock.
