A SUPPLEMENT

To the act incorporating a company to erect a bridge over Stoney creek, at Johnstown, in Cambria county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, the number of managers for the company incorporated to erect a bridge over Stoney creek at Johnstown, in Cambria county, shall be four and no more; and that the president and managers of said company shall declare dividends of the nett income from said bridge, semi-annually, on the third Monday of August next and the third Monday in February, eighteen hundred and forty-five, and on the same days semi-annually thereafter; and that so much of the act to which this a supplement, as is hereby altered and supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.
