AN ACT

Supplementary to an act passed the ninth day of April, one thousand seven hundred and sixty, relative to the hunting of deer.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, if any person or persons, in the counties of Schuylkill, Lebanon and Dauphin, shall hunt, chase or follow, with a design to kill or destroy, any buck, doe or fawn, within said counties, at any other time or season, excepting only between the first day of the month of September and the first day of the month of December in each year, and shall be lawfully convicted thereof by the oaths or affirmations of one or more credible witnesses, before any alderman or justice of the peace, in the name of the commonwealth, he or they, *on being convicted thereof*, shall forfeit and pay for every such offence the sum of twenty-five dollars, to be sued for and recoverable, with costs of suit, before any alderman or justice of the peace, in the name of the commonwealth, at the instance of any person who will sue therefor, as debts of like amount are now recoverable by law; one-half of said fine or penalty shall be paid to the person or persons suing for the same, and the other half to the treasurer of the county where such fine or penalty shall be recovered: *Provided*, That so much of the act of the ninth day of April, one thousand seven hundred and sixty, that is inconsistent with this act, be and the same is hereby repealed.
