RESOLUTION

For the payment of expenses attending the investigation of the matters of inquiry connected with the election of state printers, and for other purposes.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That the speaker of the house of representatives is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the state treasurer, in favor of Jerome K. Boyer and Jacob Ziegler, for the sum of seventy-five dollars to each, in full for their services as secretaries to the joint committee of investigation, to whom was referred so much of the message of the governor as relates to the election of state printer; and he is further hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant on the state treasurer, for the daily pay and mileage of witnesses who attended before said committee, at the rate of one dollar per day, and eight cents per mile circular: *Provided,* That the accounts of the said witnesses be first submitted to, examined and allowed by the committee on accounts of the house of representatives.

Resolved, That the committee of accounts of the senate is hereby authorized and directed to settle the account of the sergeant-at-arms of the senate, allowing him twenty-five cents for the service of subpoenas issued by the said committee, and eight cents per mile for the necessary mileage; and that the speaker of the senate be authorized to draw his warrant upon the state treasurer for the amount thus settled and allowed by the committee of accounts.
