RESOLUTION

To correct an error in the act passed the eighteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, entitled "An Act for the relief of Daniel Henderson, and others, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars."

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That the word Christian be changed to Catharine, where it occurs in the first section of the act of assembly, entitled "An Act for the relief of Daniel Henderson, and others, soldiers and widows of soldiers of the Revolutionary and Indian wars," approved the eighteenth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three; and that the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Catharine Scheetz, of Lehigh county, or her order, the gratuity and annuity directed by said act to be paid to Christian Scheetz, of said county.
