AN ACT

To reduce the expenses in Berks and Washington counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the commissioners of Berks county that may be hereafter elected or appointed, shall respectively receive out of the county treasury the sum of one dollar and fifty cents for each day they shall necessarily attend to their duties: *Provided,* That the pay of any one of the commissioners shall not exceed one hundred and fifty dollars per annum.

SECTION 2. That from and after the passage of this act, the county commissioners, auditors, and directors of the poor, for the county of Washington, shall each receive one dollar and fifty cents per day for their services: *Provided,* That the county commissioners aforesaid shall not be entitled to receive a greater amount than two hundred dollars each for their services, in any one year.

SECTION 3. That the inspectors, judges and clerks of elections, in the county of Washington, shall be entitled to receive one dollar each for their services in holding an election, and no more, except the judges, who shall be entitled to receive six cents per mile for every mile necessarily travelled, in making the return of an election.

SECTION 4. That so much of any law as is hereby altered or repealed, be and the same is hereby repealed.
