A SUPPLEMENT

To the several acts incorporating the borough of Wilkesbarre, in the county of Luzerne, and the borough of Northumberland, in the county of Northumberland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That hereafter it shall be the duty of the high constable of the borough of Wilkesbarre to give bond to the burgess and town council, in such sum as may be required, not exceeding two thousand dollars, with one or more sufficient sureties for the faithful discharge of the duties of his office, within ten days after his election: *Provided however,* That if the person elected to the office of high constable aforesaid be a freeholder, unincumbered to the amount of two thousand dollars, then and in that case he may be qualified without giving bail. Borough of Wilkesbarre.

SECTION 2. That hereafter it shall be the duty of the high constable of the borough of Northumberland, to give bond to the burgess and town council in such sum as may be required, not exceeding five hundred dollars, with one sufficient surety for the faithful discharge of the duties of his office, within ten days after his election: *Provided however,* That if the person elected to the office of high constable aforesaid be a freeholder, unincumbered to the amount of five hundred dollars, then and in that case he may be qualified without giving bail. Borough of Northumberland. Proviso.

SECTION 3. That after the year A. D. one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, it shall be the duty of the inspectors and judges of the election district of the borough of Northumberland, to conduct the election for borough officers, as well as for inspectors, judge and assessors, at the same time and place where such elections for inspectors may be held; and so much of the act of assembly incorporating the borough of Northumberland as may be inconsistent herewith, be and the same is hereby repealed.
