A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled “An Act repealing the act allowing a premium on foxes and wild cats, in the within named counties, and for other purposes,” approved the twenty-fourth day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That so much of the act to which this is a supplement, as relates to the counties York and Fayette, be and it is hereby repealed ; and that the act to ^{these} ~~ette~~ counties, which this is a supplement, be and the same is hereby extended to the county of Westmoreland.
