## A N A C T

Relating to certain turnpike road companies.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Bellefonte and the stockholders in the Bellefonte and Philipsburg turnpike road company, Philipsburg—pany, and the Philipsburg and Susquehanna turnpike road company, Philipsburg and and the Centre and Kishacoquillas turnpike road company shall each, Susquehanna, on the first Monday in March, elect by ballot five managers, (one of and the Centre whom shall be chosen president,) and such other officers as they shall think proper to manage the concerns of the said company for the ensuing turnpike road companies. year, and until others shall be duly chosen in their respective places.

SECTION 2. That should any of the stockholders be in arrears in any Forfeiture of stock subscribed to either of the said companies, it shall and may be stock. lawful for either of the said companies, to give three months notice thereof to the said subscriber, their executors or administrators, of the amount due, with lawful interest thereon, from the time the same was due and unpaid; and after such notice aforesaid, it shall and may be lawful for the said companies, within ten days thereafter, to proceed to forfeit the whole so due and unpaid, for the benefit of the said company or companies.

SECTION 3. That so much of any act or acts of assembly, as is Repeal. hereby altered and supplied, be and the same is hereby repealed.
