A SUPPLEMENT

To "An Act incorporating the Bear Valley coal company," passed the twelfth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time for the completion of the railroad or other improvements authorized to be constructed by the Bear Valley coal company, be and the same is hereby extended for the further period of five years; and the said company are hereby authorized in lieu of completing their said road, to unite with any other railroad leading or which may lead into their lands, and to subscribe to the stock thereof, the amount which they are authorized to expend in constructing their road: And provided, That instead of the notices heretofore required to be given, all notices to the stockholders of said company, shall hereafter be published for three successive weeks in one newspaper in the borough of Harrisburg.*
