A N A C T

Relating to the navigation of the Youghiogheny river.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That from and after the passage of this act, so much of the provisions of the fifth section of the act of eleventh June, eighteen hundred and forty, entitled "An Act to provide for continuing the improvements of the state, and for the payment of the interest on the state debt," which provides that all descending crafts owned by citizens of Pennsylvania, and not intending to return, shall pass free from toll on the lower division of the Monongahela improvement, is hereby extended to the Certain act made Youghiogheny river; and hereafter all boats, rafts, arks, and other applicable to. crafts descending the Youghiogheny river owned by citizens of Pennsylvania, and not calculated or intended to return, shall pass free of toll Free of toll. or other charge through any lock or locks, dam or dams, of the Monongahela navigation company.
