Reservation.

SECTION 8. That the said association shall from time to time establish and make and 'put into execution such by-laws, rules, and regulations, as may be passed from time to time by the association, or the same to revoke, annul, alter, or amend at pleasure: *Provided*, That the said rules, regulations, and by-laws be not repugnant to the constitution and laws of the United States or of the commonwealth of Pennsylvania, nor repugnant to any of the provisions of this act: *Provided*, That it shall be lawful for the legislature at any time to amend or repeal any of the foregoing provisions, and to rescind the powers hereby granted.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act incorporating the Bank of North America.

Capital stock restored, &c.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the capital stock of the Bank of North America be made and is hereby restored to one million of dollars, and the par value of the shares thereof to four hundred dollars.*
