AN ACT

For changing the time of holding courts in Adams county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the time of holding the regular terms of the several courts of Adams county, be and the same is hereby changed from the fourth Monday of January, April, August and November, the time on which the said terms are now holden, to the third Monday of the said months; and that the said act shall take effect from and after the twenty-sixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-six.* When to take effect.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to establish a seminary by the name of Haverford school association."

WHEREAS, Doubts have arisen whether the act, entitled "An Act to establish a seminary by the name of Haverford school association," does not make it unlawful for the members of the said incorporated association, to alter or repeal any of the rules, orders, regulations and constitution of the said association, as they existed at and immediately before the date of the said act; for remedy whereof, Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That nothing in the said act shall be deemed to prohibit the members of the said association at any meeting, either annual or special, from altering, amending or repealing any of the rules, orders, regulations and constitution of the said association, as they existed at and immediately before the date of the said act; and it shall be lawful for the said members, or* Power to enact by-laws, rules, &c.

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a majority thereof, to alter, amend, or repeal the same accordingly, and to make such changes therein as they shall see fit, any thing in the said act to the contrary notwithstanding: *Provided, always,* That nothing herein contained, shall be deemed to authorize the said association to pass any rule, order or regulation, contrary to the said act as hereby explained, or contrary to the laws and constitution of this commonwealth.

A SUPPLEMENT

To an act incorporating the Pittsburgh navigation and fire insurance company, passed the fifteenth day of February, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and thirty-two.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the par value of the shares in the capital stock of the said Pittsburgh navigation and fire insurance company, shall be and is hereby reduced from one hundred dollars to forty dollars each, and that so much of the act to which this is a supplement as is hereby altered and is inconsistent herewith, be and the same is hereby repealed.
