A N A C T

To authorize Charles S. Bradford, Trustee of Mary M. Brackenridge, of the county of Allegheny, to sell and convey certain real estate.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* Charles S. Bradford, of the city of Pittsburg, trustee for the separate use of Mary M. Brackenridge, wife of Alexander Brackenridge, of Allegheny county, and for the children of said Alexander Brackenridge and Mary, is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey, with the consent of said Mary, a certain piece of ground situate on the rear of ground of William A. V. Magan and wife, forty feet in breadth, by thirty feet in depth, being an interior part of lot number two hundred and twenty, in the city of Pittsburg; and further, to invest the proceeds of such sale in the reduction or extinguishment of any existing mortgages or incumbrances against said trust estate, or in the purchase of such other estate or securities, as in either case may be approved of by the court of common pleas of said county, for the same uses, benefits and trusts, as heretofore appointed.

SECTION 2. That the said trustee be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey, with the consent of said Mary, a certain house and lot of ground, containing about one acre and an half, situate in Pitt township, Allegheny county, (the same which said trustee, heretofore, purchased with the money of said trust estate from John Heron;) and further, to invest the proceeds of such sale in like manner, and for the like purposes as above directed: *Provided, however,* That before executing the powers hereby granted, the said Charles S. Bradford shall give sufficient security, to be approved of by the said court, for the faithful execution of the same.
