A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Lykens Valley coal company, in Dauphin county, Pennsylvania, and to authorize the opening of a road in Honesdale, Wayne county."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the Lykens Valley coal company, in Dauphin county, Pennsylvania, may apply any part of the funds of said company to the purchase of any number of shares of the capital stock of "The Lykens Valley railroad and coal company," or may loan any part of their funds to the said last mentioned company, upon the terms authorized by the second section of the act passed the thirteenth of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, entitled 'A further supplement to an act, entitled 'An Act incorporating the Lykens Valley railroad company, in Dauphin county,' passed the seventh day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and thirty."

Application of funds.

SECTION 2. That hereafter the election for directors of the Lykens Valley coal company, in Dauphin county, shall be held annually on the first Monday of May, at which time the stockholders shall elect seven directors to serve for one year, in the manner prescribed by the fourth section of the act to which this is a supplement; the directors now in office shall continue to serve until the first Monday of May next, or until their successors are elected; and in case of any vacancy occurring in the board of directors, such vacancy shall be filled by the remaining directors, until the next annual election; and the said Lykens Valley coal company shall have the right to own and possess such additional quantity of land, not exceeding twenty acres, in Dauphin county, as may be necessary and convenient as places of deposite, and to give facility for the shipment and sale of the products of their mines.
